

FIRE SAFETY

Fire Safety week is October 8-14. Please check your smoke detector batteries and expiration date on your extinguisher. It is recommended to have a smoke detector on each level of your home. Discuss fire safety with your child. Make sure they know to get out as fast as they can and not to hide from firefighters. Explain that if it is smokey they should get low by ducking or crawling. Make a family plan and meeting spot. Your family meeting spot should be somewhere close by but away from your home such as a tree, mailbox, or neighbor's home. This is where your child should know to go if there is a fire in your home.
