The self-guided online registration process will be available this summer. A link will be provided at our website, www.marion.k12.in.us, once online registration is open. Registration can be completed at any Internet-connected computer (including the public stations at Marion Public Library). However, computer/Internet access and staff assistance will also be available during our on-site registration days (at right).

► **ON-SITE REGISTRATION:**

Families enrolling students *new* to MCS are required to register in person. Others are welcome to. Those times are as follows:

- **July 23-30:** 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. at Justice Intermediate School, McCulloch Junior High, and Marion High School
- **July 31:** 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. at all school buildings
- **Aug. 1:** 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. at all buildings
- **Aug. 2:** 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. at all buildings
- **Aug. 3-8:** 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. at all buildings

► **Marion Regional Career Center registration**

- **Marion students:** complete regular registration process (info at left).
- **County school students:** Registration completed through partnership with MRCC and your school and finalized at start of school year.

► **MHS students, take note:**
